

Local USB Media

The Stream Magic product also supports local media from USB flash drives or USB hard drives and has two USB 1.1 ports for this purpose. Here the Stream Magic product simply browses the folders present on the media attached and displays them. Only content that the Stream Magic product can play will be shown.

If you have problems with Local Media playback always check the following:

- Check the Stream Magic product is capable of playing back the file type you are trying to access. WMA, AAC, MP3, Ogg Vorbis, FLAC and WAV can currently be played.
- The Stream Magic product does not support ALAC, WMA Pro, WMA lossless, RAW, AU or other file types not mentioned.
- For local media the Stream Magic product can only play non DRM files. Files that have DRM controls cannot be played.
- Check your device is formatted in FAT32 format.
- The way you organise your local media affects the size of internal database the Stream Magic product needs to build dynamically as you browse content.
- Check that your USB storage device does not require more current than the Stream Magic product can supply via the USB port. For example, the NP30 cannot supply greater than 500mA from the USB socket itself. Please check the Stream Magic product's user manual for details.

Good practice is to create folders for Artists within which you should have sub folders for each Album which then contain the tracks for that Album. Libraries with thousands of tracks in one folder will progressively slow down the Stream Magic product's media browsing.
